

30 May 2026: Closure of the Brenner Corridor

Avoid non-essential travel!



INFO

Due to a planned demonstration, the **Austrian A13 Brenner motorway** and the **B182 Brenner road** will be **completely closed in North Tyrol on 30 May** from the border crossing between 11:00 and 19:00 (a driving ban for lorries will be in effect from 09:00).

As a result, the **A22 Brenner motorway will be closed northbound from Sterzing between 10:30 and 20:00**. Increased traffic volumes and restrictions are also to be expected on the days before and after 30 May.



WHAT APPLIES TO SOUTH TYROL?

- **Closure of the A22 Brenner motorway northbound from Sterzing** from 10:30 to 20:00 to all traffic.
- In the event of heavy congestion, the **point of closure may be moved to Bressanone, Chiusa or Bolzano**.
- **National ban on lorries on the A22 Brenner motorway** from 07:00
- **Ban on lorries** over 7.5 tonnes **on all roads in South Tyrol** from 07:00 to 20:00. Exceptions apply!
- **Increased police presence** and **surveillance** along the Brenner corridor.



RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Avoid non-essential travel.
2. Plan an alternative route avoiding South Tyrol.
3. If travelling by car, ensure you have sufficient water and provisions.
4. Monitor the traffic information centre and navigation systems for updates.



LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport is expected to operate on schedule.

Due to high demand, **delays, cancellations and overcrowding are possible on trains and buses**. Please check the [Südtirolmobil website](#) before setting off. Avoid non-essential travel.
